

FIU McNair Graduate Fellowship Fall 2018

The FIU McNair Graduate Fellowship was created to encourage promising undergraduate FIU McNair Scholars to continue to pursue their graduate education at Florida International University. FIU's University Graduate School will award a limited number of FIU McNair Graduate Fellowships to undergraduate FIU McNair Scholars based on a nomination from their graduate program. To be considered for the fellowship, a student must be fully admitted to a master's or doctoral degree program at FIU for the Fall 2018 semester. Preference will be given to students who are entering a doctoral program.

Doctoral Student Awards

FIU McNair Graduate Fellowships for doctoral students provide four years of support with a \$23,000 annual stipend plus a tuition waiver and individual health insurance. The University Graduate School will provide the support for the first two years in the form of a fellowship. The academic department will continue to provide the same level of support during the 3rd and 4th years through a (0.5 FTE) teaching or research assistantship. Students may not receive other FIU fellowships or fellowships from outside agencies during the first two years of the award.

Master's Student Awards

FIU McNair Graduate Fellowships for master's students provide a \$15,000 stipend for the first year, plus a tuition waiver and individual health insurance. In the second year, the student's academic department will continue the same level of support by providing the student a (0.5FTE) graduate or research assistantship. Students may not receive other FIU fellowships or fellowships from outside agencies during the first year of the award.

Eligibility - Nominees must:

- be a US Citizen or Permanent Resident
- be newly admitted to/entering a master's or doctoral degree program at FIU for the Fall 2018 semester (currently enrolled graduate students are not eligible)
- have participated in and complete the McNair Scholars Program at FIU
- have a GPA of 3.5 or higher in upper division undergraduate coursework

Nominations

Nominations are submitted by the admitting graduate academic program via the FIU McNair Graduate Fellowship Nomination Form. Nominees must be admitted to the graduate program before the fellowship application can be considered. In addition to the completed nomination form, the following supporting documents are also required:

- Letter from McNair Program director confirming the student's participation in and completion of the McNair program at FIU on official school letterhead
- Student's personal statement outlining his/her undergraduate accomplishments and graduate education goals
- Student's Resume/CV
- Letter from proposed FIU mentor in graduate program

Nomination Form Deadline

The FIU McNair Graduate Fellowship application and all supporting documents must be submitted to UGS, MARC 240, no later than **March 23rd, 2018**.

FIU McNair Graduate Fellowship Nomination Form
