MESSAGE FROM THE DEAN

IMPORTANT DEADLINES

The University Graduate School is reexamining the timeline for reviewing applications for graduate admission. In particular, we are interested in three stages of the review process:

D-5/M-3 Deadline for Spring 2015 Graduation
(due three weeks before defense)
March 6, 2015

1. The time span elapsed between receipt of application and referral to unit (applications reside at UGS)
2. The time span elapsed between referral to unit and admission decision (applications reside in the unit)
3. The time taken by UGS to prepare the admission decision letter and notify students of further formalities (I-20 processing, etc.)


We intend to gather data from all of our programs and identify areas for improvement. This is a much-needed follow-up to our decision last year to move application deadlines to earlier dates. It is important that our processes encourage timely decisions on applications and assistantships so we may attract top-quality applicants to FIU. It is even more important that our processes prevent any application from being held for extended periods without a decision; that would damage our credibility and reputation.

U.S. Department of Homeland Security Chemical and Biological Defense Division Research Participation Program Positions

The Chemical and Biological Defense Division (CBD) of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Science & Technology Directorate (S&T) manages a research portfolio of approximately \$100 million and works to increase the Nation's preparedness against chemical and biological threats through improved threat awareness, advanced surveillance and detection, and responsive countermeasures. CBD offers research opportunities to postgraduates through the DHS Research Participation Program managed by the Oak Ridge Institute for Science and Education (ORISE). CBD is seeking individuals for the following positions:

- DHS Systems Engineering in Biosurveillance Post-Master's or Doctoral Research Participant
- DHS Agricultural Defense Postdoctoral Research Participant
- DHS Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear - Terrorism Risk Assessment Research Participant

All positions require:

1. Knowledge of a broad spectrum of potential chemical and biological threats, and medical and non-medical countermeasure strategies, which might be effective at mitigating impact of an incident or attack.
2. A background investigation and eligibility for a SECRET security clearance.
3. U.S. citizenship.

Graduate Faculty and DAS Applications Now Available

Complete DAS and graduate faculty applications—including the departmental and college level recommendations—are **due at UGS by March 15th, 2015** (we will accept applications from the colleges until 5:00 pm on Monday, March 16th). We strongly recommend that all applications be submitted in a timely manner to your respective college/school dean, allotting for enough time (at least two weeks) for the application to be reviewed and assessed before it is submitted to UGS. Applications received after March 15th will be automatically moved into the fall evaluation cycle.
