**FIU/UM PhD Exchange Program Announcement
Fall 2009-Spring 2010**

FIU Doctoral students (PhD and EdD) have the opportunity to complete up to six credits at the University of Miami as members of an exchange program between FIU and the University of Miami. The program gives doctoral students a larger selection of courses to choose from and allows students at UM and FIU to take advantage of the educational and research opportunities at both institutions. All students who are fully admitted into a doctoral program may participate in this program. *Students can choose from any course at the University of Miami provided the course is not already offered at FIU and is not a limited access course.*

FIU students participating in the program continue to pay FIU tuition and fees for the courses they take at the University of Miami (i.e. they will only be assessed regular FIU tuition and fees). Students are limited to taking a maximum of six graduate credits within the program.

Interested students can find the 2009-2010 application form online under "Announcements" at gradschool.fiu.edu. Applications must be received by FIU's University Graduate School, PC 230, by August 14th to enroll for the fall 2009 semester or by December 11th to enroll for the spring 2010 semester.

The FIU/UM PhD Program is a true intellectual exchange between FIU and the University of Miami and a unique academic opportunity for all students who decide to participate.
