- 1) Full-time graduate student status OR complete FIU application to our Radiochemistry Ph.D. track processed through Univ. Grad. School (for incoming students)**
 - 2) Graduate GPA of 3.3 or higher**
 - 3) US Citizenship or Permanent US Residence**

Students with interest in nuclear & radiochemistry careers are encouraged to apply

Students who accept this research fellowship are obligated to sign the NRC fellowship program service agreement that requires either 6 months of nuclear-related employment per year of NRC support with a Federal or State Agency, a DOE lab, or company. How to apply: Submit 1-4 as one package (electronically or in paper):

- 1) Personal statement of research interests (for incoming students) or 1-2 page description of research project and progress and its program relevance (for current Ph.D. graduate students).**
- 2) Current Undergraduate and Graduate Transcripts (unofficial)**
- 3) CV/Resume including Publication/Presentation List**
- 4) Latest Annual Progress Evaluation and Mentoring Form (if applicable)**
- 5) Three confidential letters of recommendation to the address (or email):**
