

Provost Degree Completion Tuition Fellowship Guidelines – Summer 2023

The Provost Degree Completion Tuition Fellowship is intended to facilitate degree completion by providing tuition waivers for Ph.D. students whose Graduate Assistantships (GAs), UGS Fellowships, or other funding have expired, and who are nearing the completion of their degree and are facing *extenuating* financial circumstances that will prevent them from being continuously enrolled in their Ph.D. Program. This fellowship is awarded for a *maximum of two terms*. If the student is awarded this fellowship and fails to complete the degree within the allocated term(s), the respective college will lose a corresponding tuition waiver. **These fellowships are not intended to extend DYFs**.

Funding decisions will be based on certainty of graduation within one or two terms, history of funding for the student by UGS and/or the College, and student performance (including time to-degree).

NOMINATION PROCEDURE:

Applications must be submitted to ugsfellows@fiu.edu in a single pdf file ugsfellows@fiu.edu in a single pdf file by the College Associate Dean for Graduate Education during the term prior to the term in which the tuition fellowship will be used.

Nominations for the Summer 2023 award must be submitted by **Tuesday**, **March 7**, **2023**.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION:

- Nomination Form including attestation signed by both the student and the major professor that the student will complete the degree by the proposed timeline (attached).
- 2. A plan delineating when the student will complete the degree requirements and graduate (maximum of two terms).
