

2024-2025 Graduate Student Publication Fund

To support high level research activity and scholarly productivity of FIU doctoral students, University Graduate school invites applications to the Graduate Student Publication Fund. The fund will provide **up to \$2,500** to cover the following publishing costs for graduate students whose research papers have been accepted by peer-reviewed and reputable academic journals: 1) open access article processing charges (APCs) 2) excess page or image charges

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Must be a currently enrolled Ph.D. student at FIU or a recent graduate (within a year of graduation).
- Must be the first author on an *accepted (but not yet published)* high quality publication* which lists FIU as the primary institutional affiliation.
- Must provide proof of publication acceptance
- If the total amount is above \$ 2,500, the applicant is responsible for providing proof of availability of funding for the remaining balance
- For applicants with APC charges: 1) The journal must be listed in the Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ) <https://doaj.org/> 2) The publisher must be a member of the Open Access Scholarly Publishers Association (OASPA) or adheres to its code of conduct
- If the research was sponsored, APCs or other charges were not allocated in the budget
- One application may be submitted per eligible publication
- Students with multiple outstanding acceptances should prioritize which publication they wish to submit first; additional requests will be considered only if funds are available
- Conference proceedings are **not** eligible
