***Health Insurance.** Health insurance is mandatory, but you can opt out of our plan if you currently hold an equivalent insurance plan. To opt-out of the University plan, please visit <https://fiu.mycare26.com/> for more details. Please note the deadline to opt out is **September 15, 2025**. The insurance premium for this plan is paid 100% by the University Graduate School while receiving your fellowship stipend. If applicable, when you begin your assistantship while being a fellow, you are expected to pay 17% portion of the insurance premium (as required of all GA/TA/RAs) once hired by the Department.

****Fees** – All fees listed are based on the 2025-26 academic year and are subject to change. Some classes have associated fees which are in addition to the regular tuition and, therefore, are not covered by the waiver. Amount you owe is based on above per credit and semester fees; it does NOT include tuition plus, lab, or online fees.

Taxes – If your fellowship is paid via contract through HR, your taxes will be automatically deducted from your biweekly paycheck. For fellowships paid via financial aid in a lump sum, tax calculations and payments are the responsibility of the fellow. Additionally, fellowships used for living expenses are subject to U.S. taxes (if you are an international student, the University is required to withhold taxes on the portion of the fellowship used for living expenses unless there is a tax treaty between your country and the United States. These taxes will not be deducted from the fellowship but rather posted on your student account as a tax charge. You will be required to pay the charge by the final day to pay deadline for each semester).
